The 2020-2021 scholarships and recipients are:

The Greenawald Memorial Scholarship (\$1,000)

Has been awarded to Ayla Blatt, who will be continuing at Penn State University (University Park, PA) studying Animal Science and Agribusiness Management.

Ray Hoffman Memorial Scholarship for Aquarium and Zoo Science (\$500)

Has been awarded to Olivia Theisen, a graduate of Parkland High School, who will be attending St. Francis University (Loretto, PA) to study Aquarium and Zoo Science.
